
# Where do we drop the ball?

- Translations fail to move upstream
- Bugs filed in distribution or upstream
- Patches in distributions not sent upstream
- Planning changes in one project affect another
- Problems in shared libraries affect many projects


# Barriers to better collaboration

# Collaborating on translation



  - Federation vs centralisation
  - Standards for describing bug data
  - Standard API's for automated data flow
  - Standards for bug meta-data, too!

I'm sick and tired of finding that my digital camera card is full after deleting all the pictures, and my iAudio still plays deleted files.

This is because instead of deleting files from removal devices, Nautilus creates a .Trash-\$USER directory and moves the files into there.

Can we please make the default be to \_not\_ do this? It makes (some) sense for the main drive, but removable ones tend to be "temporary" storage. A better



- Free software developers don't believe in long term plans: "agile", "evolving", "release early, release often", "when it's done".
- Projects have interdependencies, so project delays do have greater consequences
- The best projects communicate their plans well:
  - GNOME, Mozilla, OpenOffice, Linux, Python

# We LOVE blueprints at Ubuntu

- Lightweight specification process
  - not a formal system specification, but a rough idea
  - helps focus community attention on projects
  - creates a language for describing work underway
  - organise and prioritise work and landings



# Version control is essential ingredient

- Centralised version control powered the early free software revolution
  - CVS
  - Subversion

# Distributed version control

- No second-class citizens
- Creates some new challenges
  - Distributed code can be harder to find
  - Less pressure to bake a real release
- Several free contenders
  - Git, Bazaar

# Bazaar – key ingredients for success

- Cross-platform development
- Network-oriented: HTTP and custom protocols
- Huge test suite
- Robust in the face of radical tree morphing
- Fast enough for most projects

# Very poor collaboration between distros

- Patches don't travel well
- Diverse forms of packaging
  - spec / rpm, deb, ebuild, ports
- No metadata to coordinate similar work across distributions

# Plans to improve package collaboration

- Standardise package patch management
- Distributed VCS
  - Every patch becomes a branch
- Improve access of upstreams to distro VCS

- Rich team structures make for rapid response and creativity
- Competition and collaboration go hand in hand
