ACCU is a worldwide association of people with an interest in C, C++, C#, Java, Python and other related languages. Its members include people just starting out as well as professional programmers and companies writing software. It is run by a volunteer committee, and on behalf of the membership maintains a web site and aims to produce twelve journals a year and to organise a spring conference.

Membership benefits

The main ACCU journal is "C Vu", which typically contains 36 pages of articles, letters and the world renowned book reviews, all produced by members.

A second 28 page journal "Overload", produced in alternation with "C Vu", is available for more advanced programmers and concentrates on issues such as class structure, object oriented design etc.

The web site gives access to discussions on various topics together with code from the journals, book reviews and back issues. New members can join on-line.

There is a 4-day conference held in the spring during April together with the AGM. The conference gives an opportunity to hear world class speakers from the fields of C, C++, Java, C#, Python and other programming-related areas. Members can attend at reduced rates.

Full membership gives all the above benefits. Basic membership gives all the above benefits with the exception of "Overload".

A full time student (worldwide) discount of 50% is offered on both types of membership.

Corporate membership gives all the above benefits. In addition five copies of each journal are provided and all staff at the corporate members address are eligible for the conference discount.

ACCU helps to fund UK Standards work through the ISDF fund. This goes to assist UK technical experts attending standards working group meetings. ACCU members who contribute have the option of asking to be provided with access to ISO C and C++ standardisation documents.

Your renewal date will be the end of the month in which we receive your application. Journals are published monthly, and you will receive the next issue of whichever journal is published next.
